- **Lunch at Café Zest**

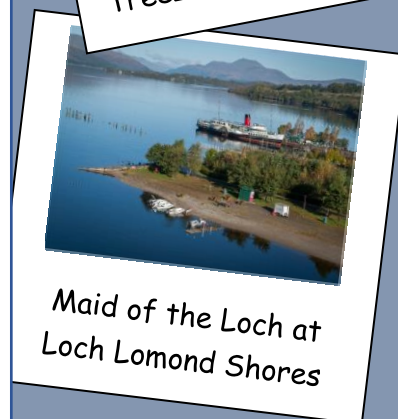
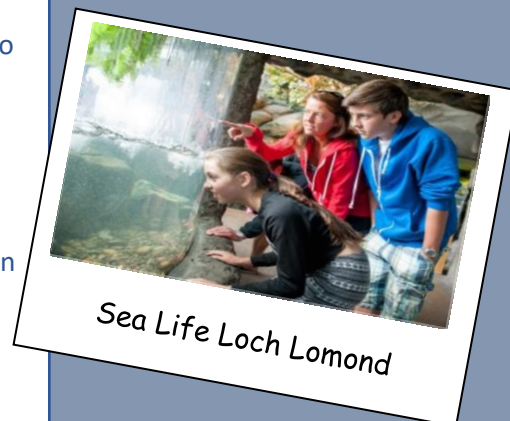
Tuck into a tasty lunch with wonderful Loch Lomond views at Café Zest within Jenners department store at Loch Lomond Shores.
